

Reserve Medicos Go Cool!

The Australian Defence Force will soon take delivery of new medical tents for in-the-field use, known as Controlled Environment Soft Shelters.

The revolutionary tents are a component of JP2060 – the ADF Deployable Medical Facility.

In the future, Air Force Reserve medicos and their counterparts, many of whom are amongst the most qualified medical practitioners and specialists in Australia, will benefit from the high-tech concept.

The Controlled Environment Soft Shelters are expected to enhance the ADF's ability to provide high grade medical and dental care for deployed forces.

Weatherhaven Australia, a Nowra based contractor, will provide 100 of the canvas modular tent systems, including connecting units which enable them to be assembled and configured for different medical functions.
